

After graduating with a bachelor's degree in chemistry, I completed a degree and master's program in theology. After that, I taught theology in various seminaries and colleges. In addition, I lead the youth of five different denominations in the same area. This fellowship was established 6 years ago and many works have been done by the union. In addition to fellowship, we do many charity works and fasting prayers together. At this time, I am facilitating the transfer of this union to the next leader by preparing a successor. I am moving to the city where I live in other cities and doing the work of revitalization by training young people and teenagers. Through this service, God has given me many victories. The young people who participate in the training go to their churches and train other people who did not come to the training. I will monitor this by meeting with the leaders. Everyone is very happy with the training because the main concept of the training is to bring people back to the teachings of Christ Jesus and the true meaning of God's word.

I know Papa Chico personally because he is a good mentor and a father to me. He never forgot me in his prayers. I am very happy that he is supporting my ministry by being on the side of my family. Our relationship with Papa is not only of ministry but also of family. When he comes to Ethiopia, he never leaves without visiting my house and drinking coffee. My dear wife and I thank God so much for Papa Chico and Mama Daisy.
