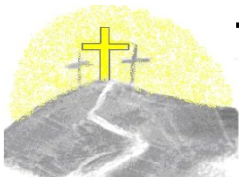

Upcoming Mission Trip:

Seven training/fellowship community events in seven different locations in Ethiopia, are confirmed for April 3rd through the 27th, 2024. We will focus on follow-up visits and next step training to the seven existing groups. Each of these groups are located in different strategic regions throughout Ethiopia and engage in a series of progressive exegetical Biblical studies (See TMMI Training Sequence below) designed to teach, implement and maintain Biblical Missiology, Biblical Ecclesiology and Biblical Spiritual Formation as taught by Master Jesus, His Apostles/disciples and the early church leaders.

TMMI Training Sequence:

1. The Gospel in Accordance with the Scriptures—The Gospel of the Kingdom
2. The Kingdom Life According to Jesus—The Great Sermon
3. The Masters Plan-Servant—Disciple Multiplication and Servant Leader Development
4. The Church that Jesus is Building
5. What is Church—A Biblical Ecclesiology
6. God's Word—Our Ultimate Authority
7. Interpreting the Scriptures
8. Living Christian

Since the onset of this process, we have witnessed miraculous fruit and inspiring life and ministry transformation. Below are just two of the most recent reports I would like to share with you.

Updates from our students from Ethiopia:

1. Yosef / Joseph/ Zeleke – From Yirgachefe, Ethiopia

Yosef/Joseph/, we call him Jossy as a nick name; is one of our students in our Hawassa hub center. He is serving in the town called Yirgachefe; the place where the world class best coffee production area in the country. He has planted a number of churches in the region and a leader of in our church called Yirgachefe local church.

After he takes our teachings; he also teaches other leaders and church planters in his church and from other churches. According to his report; so far, he has trained more than 50 leaders and church planters. He said that the teachings are powerful and totally based on Bible and challenge the existing beliefs of many Christians & Church leaders which is contrary to the Bible. He added that the lessons like 'The Gospel in Accordance of the Scripture' and the true meaning of the 'Kingdom of God' and 'Church' have transformed his life and the lives of many leaders that he is teaching.

One of things that makes Joseph unique is that he is serving the church by doing tent -making job. He has his own barber shop in the town and make money to support himself and his ministry. He said that he uses his barber shop as a platform to share the Gospel with his customers. We thank God for this young visionary man!!!

2. Gossa Dhaba/Pst. / – From Bale-Robe, Ethiopia

Pastor Gossa Dhaba is also one of our students in our Shashamane training hub center. He serves in the town called Bale-Robe where the most predominantly Muslim regions in Ethiopia. After he takes our trainings, he trains two groups of people from his church and from other churches from the surrounding areas. The first group is 15 of church leaders and church planters; the other group is 10 of young emerging new leaders.

According to Pst. Gossa; his team love the teachings and has been given them a new insight from the word of God. He added that as the result of the impact of the teachings in the lives of his team the church is growing and they were able to baptize a total 16 new converts / 8-adults and 9 youths/.
